AMENDMENTS TO BYLAWS**

**ARTICLE VIII
COMMITTEES**

Section 5. Membership Committee. The duties of the Membership Committee are as follows:

- (f) Distribute Membership Application to all current members by November 15 of each year;

**ARTICLE III
MEMBERS**

Section 8. Membership Dues. All dues are nonrefundable and payable by December 31 of each year. No dues shall be prorated. No one may be a member without paying dues. All annual dues shall be set by the Board of Directors. If the Associate status of a member changes to Professional status during the fiscal year, the difference between the dues shall be paid upon the change of status. If the Graduate status of a member changes to Associate or Professional status during the fiscal year, the difference between the dues shall be paid upon the change of status.

**ARTICLE III
MEMBERS' MEETINGS**

Section 5. Notice of Meetings. Written notice stating the date, time, and place of the meeting shall be given not less than 10 nor more than 60 days before the date of any members' meeting, either by personal delivery, or by mail or private carrier, or any form of wire or wireless communication, or by facsimile transmission or other form of electronic communication, by or at the direction of the Board of Directors, the President, the Secretary, or other person calling the meeting, to each member entitled to vote at such meeting; provided that such notice must be given to all members with respect to any meeting at which a merger is to be considered and in such other instances as required by law. The notice shall describe the means of remote communication which may be used by members to participate in the meeting. If mailed, such notice shall be deemed to be effective when deposited in the United States mail, correctly addressed to the member at the member's address as it appears on the current record of members of the corporation, with postage thereon prepaid.

**ARTICLE III
MEMBERS' MEETINGS**

Section 14. Remote Participation in Meetings. If authorized by the corporation's Board of Directors, members of any class or series designated by the Board of Directors may participate in any meeting of members by means of remote communication. Participation by means of remote communication shall be subject to such guidelines and procedures as the Board of Directors adopts and shall be in conformity with this Section 14. Members participating in a members' meeting by means of remote communication shall be deemed present and may vote at such meeting if the corporation has implemented reasonable measures to do all of the following: (1) verify that each person participating remotely is a member; and (2) provide each member participating remotely a reasonable opportunity to participate in the meeting and to vote on matters submitted to the members, including an opportunity to communicate and read or hear the proceedings of the meeting, substantially concurrently with such proceedings.
